Holiday Homework (Nursery)

“There is no time to be bored in a world as beautiful as this. “

1. Be secure: - Today's world is not a safe place as it used to be a few decades back. Make your child learn the emergency numbers and their parent's phone number.

2. Helping time: - All mothers work hard for their families whether household work or their office. Let's try to make them feel free by helping them in their work. Help them in watering plants, changing pillow/cushion covers, keeping things on their places.

3. Colouring time: --The world would be a boring place without the colours. So let's do some colouring and enjoy. Scribble with crayon on paper sheet in 2parts, 4parts, 6parts and 8 parts. ***Remember the child use up-down and left-right-left strokes and not to merge colouring in the other part.**



4. Album making: - Let's revise the things we learned in our O.V.C . Make an album by pasting pictures of objects related to alphabet 'A' (ant, airport, etc.) and circle shape (clock, cookie, etc.).

5. Ball making: - To clear the concept of big and small make two newspaper balls. One should be small and the other one should be big. Ask your child to identify which one is small and which is big.

6. Zigzag walk and find the home: -Take two baskets, one full of toys and the other one empty. Put piles of books and other things in a straight line on the floor. Put the baskets on the two ends of

the track. Let your child run in zigzag line across the track and pick up a toy and take it to its home (the empty basket).

7. Make your own table mat: - Using a table mat is a good habit. To inculcate this habit in your child help them in making their own mat and using it daily. Take an A3 size paper and write your child's name on it using wax. Make the border on the paper by palm prints of your child and in the remaining place make a butterfly by the foot print of your child and then get that sheet laminated. It will be with you as memories of your child.

8. Connecting peg: - To develop your child's concentration, ask them to put the pegs in a string and make a chain.

9. Inserting Crayon/ Pencil: - To develop finer motor skills and cognitive skills of your child, take an empty cardboard box, make small holes in it and ask you child to insert crayons or pencils in those holes and then remove them.



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
