- To gain in confidence and be able to perform on stage.

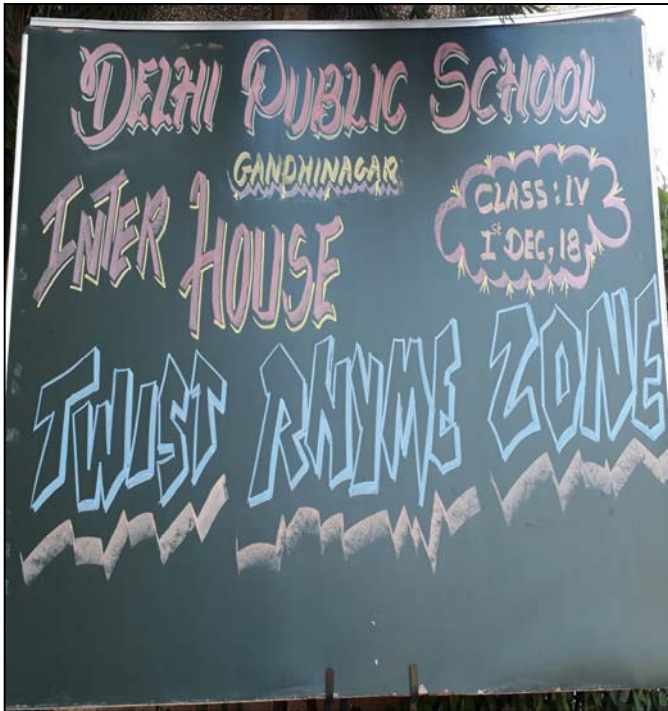
The Event and Participation
