About the Event

Delhi Public School, Gandhinagar organized '***MOUSE MAGIC MANIA (E-Drawing Competition) 2024-25***' for the Students of **Std. 3** on **6th December 2024**. The Computer Event was a vibrant celebration of creativity, where participants showcased their artistic skills using the MS Paint application. The event was divided into two segments: one focused on "The Warli Art" and the other on "My Favourite Festival." This event aimed to combine traditional art forms with modern technology, allowing participants to explore and express their creativity in a digital medium.

Objective of the Event

Segment 1: "The Warli Art"

Warli Art is a traditional form of tribal art originating from the Warli tribe of Maharashtra, India. Known for its simplistic yet intricate style, Warli Art features geometric patterns, motifs inspired by nature, and depictions of rural life. In this segment, participants were tasked with creating their own versions of Warli Art using MS Paint.

The second segment of the event allowed participants to express their love for their favorite festivals through digital art. Using MS Paint, participants created vibrant, colorful illustrations depicting scenes from festivals such as Diwali, Independence day, etc.

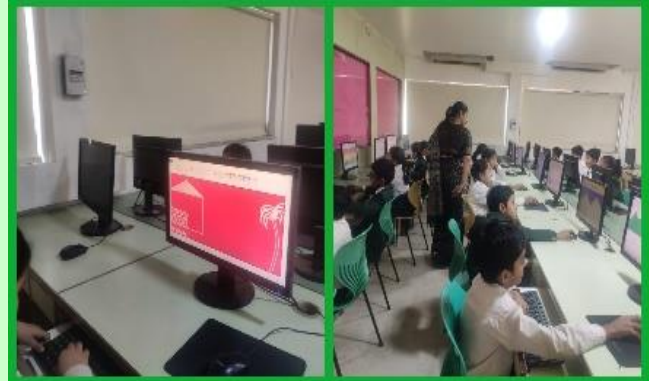
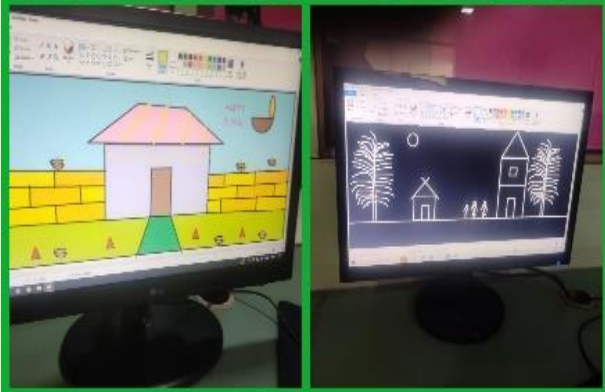
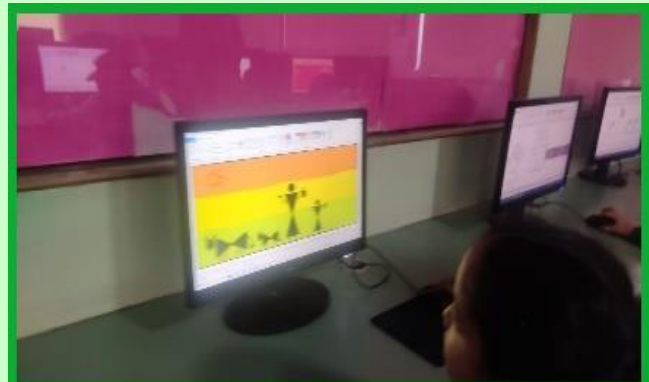
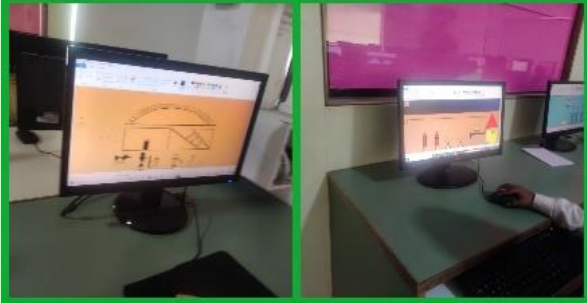
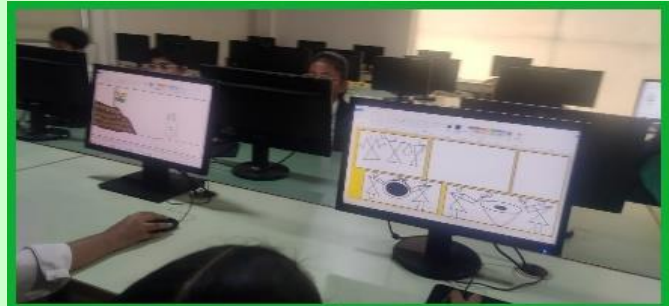
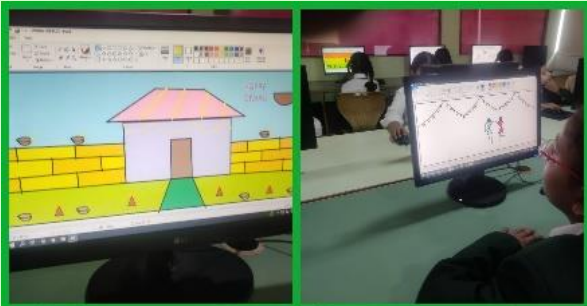
Highlights of the Segment:
