## Mathematics - 2D Plan, 'My Dream House'



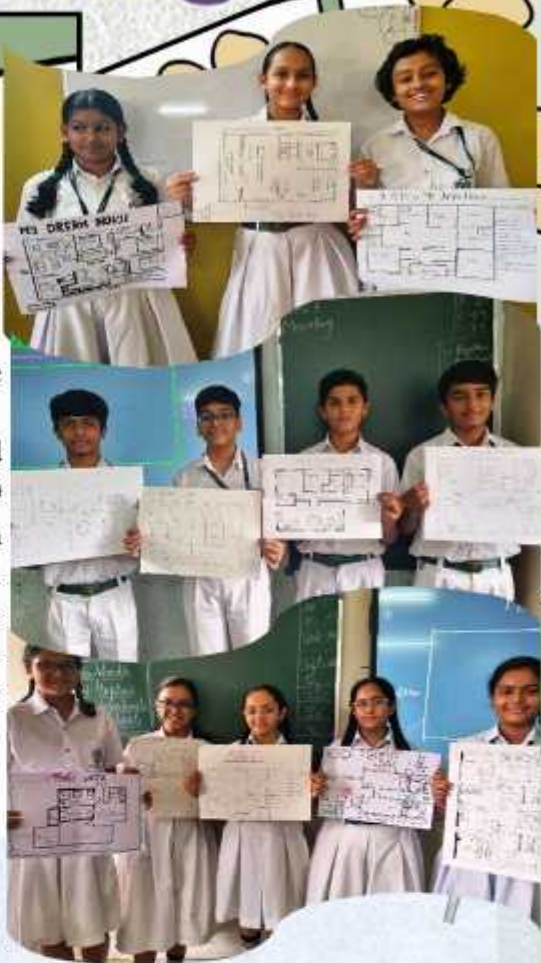
